Punctuality for week beginning 31st January 2022

- A lot of children are arriving on time every day this week, but NO class had every child in on time every day.
- A total of **10 hours and 20 minutes** of learning time was lost because **16 children** were late for school. Some were late on more than one occasion.

Parents/ carers have a responsibility to ensure their child/ren arrives to school on time and attends every day.

If a child is late they miss the start of lessons which may impact their learning.

Lateness not only disrupts your child but also their class and the staff working with them.

School gates open at 8:45 and school begins at 8.55, after which time children should enter through the office.

Being 5 minutes late every day will result in your child losing around three learning days per year.

Being 15 minutes late every day equates to missing 10 days of school a year.

Being 30 minutes late every day equates to losing nineteen learning days (nearly a school month) per year.

Persistent lateness can result in a penalty notice being issued, which carries a fine.

School Fundraising

Sponsored Timetables: Last week children in Years 1 to 6 were tested on their timetables. They will have been given a slip to confirm how many they got right in 5 minutes.

Thank you to all parents and carers who have supported their child(ren), please now collect in the sponsor money. Sponsorship forms and money should be brought into the office by this Friday, 11th February.

Red Nose Day: On Friday 18th March we will be asking children to pay £1 to come to school in Non Uniform. All money raised will go to Comic Relief and their worthy causes.

Non Uniform Day: on Friday 1st April we will be having a non uniform day. Children will be asked to donate £1. This will be put to good use within school for our pupils.

Film Night for Aid2Africa



On Tuesday, 15th February we will be holding a 'Film Night' to raise money for Aid to Africa. This fundraising can help towards tuition, provide two meals a day, school uniform and as well as basic health care and other welfare costs.

The film night is for all year groups and will start straight after school. Children will have drinks and snacks provided for them. The cost of Film Night is £3 per child and is to be paid either online via the app, or with a card or cash in the office by this Friday 11th February.

EYFS will be sharing a range of **Stories and Songs**, until 4pm. **KS1** will be watching **Hook**.

Years 3 & 4 will be watching **Encanto**. **Years 5 & 6** will be watching **Into the Woods**.

This film is rated as a PG. With the exception of EYFS, all films are due to finish at approximately **4.45pm**

Online Safety Update

We continue with our focusing on a different game, streaming service or social media app each week; sharing the best aspects of them, the risks and how to change settings and improve your child's experiences online.

This week our focus is on the popular game, Fortnite.

Fortnite is a multiplayer 'battle royale' game played online which can be played on various games consoles and gadgets. It is often quoted as the most popular game for both adults and young adults and is PEGI rated at 13+. It is played by 53% of the school population and is very popular with our Key Stage 2 children with 50% of them saying they play it at home.

Although it can be great fun to play, players do still need to stay vigilant whilst online as security isn't watertight and you can still come across problems.

In the guides, you'll find tips on a number of potential risks such as the addictive nature of Fortnite, how to keep yourself safe when playing with strangers, avoiding the traps of V Bucks and what to do if anyone does something that upsets or worries you. Please read through the guide to make yourself aware of these issues and how support your child whilst playing this game at home.
