Flu Immunisation

The deadline for giving consent for your child to receive their Flu Immunisation (nasal spray) in school has now passed. For those who have completed the online consent document, for children in Reception through to Year 6. They will be receiving their Flu Immunisation in school next Monday, 22nd November. Non Uniform Day

Friday 26th November we will be having a non uniform day. All children are invited to wear their casual clothes to school in exchange for £1 - donations are to be paid in class on the day please. Please ensure children wear suitable clothing for school, no bare shoulders, cropped tops, or shoes with heels or wheels.

EYFS Nativity

Our Nursery & Reception (EYFS) children will be performing their Nativity production to parents and carers on Wednesday 15th December, at a time to be confirmed. This performance will take place in the same manner as our other occasions this term, with letters being sent out to parents and carers to book ONE adult place per child.



Community Christmas Lunch

This year we are re-opening our doors for our Community Christmas Lunch. The letter was sent home last week. Christmas lunch will be across two days, **Thursday 16th December and Friday 17th December.** Families will be allocated one of these days. Due to reduced capacity, we will be inviting **one adult for each family**. The cost for the adult attending will be £3.25. The cost of lunch will be free to those children in receipt of Free School Meals and all children in Reception, Year 1 & Year 2. For all other children, the cost will be £2.25. Children's meals can be paid for in advance on the APP as normal, adult meals can also be paid for on the APP - the item is called Community Christmas Lunch.

We will be having our annual Christmas Party Day - date and details are to be confirmed.

Film Night

To support our school fundraising we will be holding a Film Night for all children in their Key Stages, EYFS (nursery & reception) KS1 (years 1 & 2) Lower KS2 (years 3 & 4) and Upper KS2 (years 5 & 6) on Tuesday 7th December, letters with full details will be sent home this week. Recently there have been some concerns over children watching films/tv series on Netflix that are not age appropriate.

Netflix is a subscription-based streaming service that allows users to watch TV shows and movies on any internet-enabled device that supports the software, such as smart TVs, phones and tablets. The pandemic saw a surge in children consuming on-demand content as many families relaxed their screen-time rules. Netflix's diverse range of programming caters for all age groups - so it's important for parents to recognise the potential risks of children using the service and the measures to help their child enjoy a safe streaming experience.
