British Science Week

To celebrate British Science Week 8th – 17th March 2024 we have a fabulous, exciting day planned with a visit from real scientists on



Monday 11th March. The day will begin with a 'whole school assembly'.

Children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 will then participate in Science Workshops with our visiting scientists. Children in Years 1 and 2 will have their own science workshops with our school scientists!

Years 3 and 4 will have a workshop called **Detective Science**. This will be a fun science workshop where children will use scientific techniques to solve crimes. From fingerprints to chromatography and chemical testing of mystery substances. All very C.S.I!

Years 5 and 6 will have a workshop called **Power Rangers** where there are a range a of different ways to power electricity. This worship is full of powerful things! From solar, wind and a bit of human power! This includes making their own windmill to take home. It's not cheap having scientists coming in to school for a whole day of specific workshops, we are asking for a contribution towards the cost of these workshops of £6 per child, for all children in years 3, 4, 5 & 6. This can be paid for via the MyEd app — Science Workshops.

Years 1 and 2 will be creating their own workshop where they will participate in a range of small experiments. Children in Years 1 and 2 will be participating in the Whole School Assembly with the visiting scientists. We are asking for a contribution of £3 towards the cost of their workshops.
