SNAPCHAT HAS A PEGI RATING OF 13 YEARS AND OVER. IT IS NOT RECOMMENDED FOR PRIMARY SCHOOL AGED CHILDREN AND IS THEREFORE INAPPROPRIATE FOR ANY CHILD AT OUR SCHOOL TO USE.

When the children were surveyed 57% of Year 5 and 6 and 33% of KS1 children admit to regularly using the app.
