1	LG: I can hold the djembe in the correct position and play open tone, bass tone and slap Respect	Demonstrate holding the djembe in the correct position and name the parts of the drum. Introduction Teach master drummer (leader) start and finish- 'Play the djembe' and open tone, bass tone and slap- children copy patterns and rhythms created by leader Teach 'What's for dinner mum' as the call. Children to create a solo between 5-10 seconds long (have time to develop) then they will pass around the circle	Djembe, hold position, open tone, bass tone and slap
