Protective Behaviours is a practical and down to earth approach we use to teach personal safety.

Feelings are feelings! It is important to know when we are feeling safe and when it's ok to have some adventurous fun. It can feel fun to take risks, when we have choice, control and time limit.



During Spring term all children will be learning about **Valuing Difference** in their PSHE lessons.

This unit will help children to develop respectful relationships with others, recognise bullying and, for older children, to understand their responsibilities as a bystander. This contributes to a school's work around British values.

They will be learning:

- Things that make us the same or different from each other.
- Celebrating our differences.
- Showing kindness at home and in the community.
- Why is listening carefully important? How can I be a good listener?
