**Years 1, 2, & 3 will have their session on Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> June.**

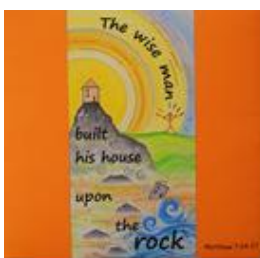
We will of course take lots of photos of all of these sessions and for those children who have permission, we will share them on the school website and Facebook page.

## Attendance and Punctuality for week beginning 1<sup>st</sup> June 2026

If your child is unwell and not able to attend school, you must inform us, either by calling the office and leaving a message via the absence line or sending a message via MyEd app, before 9am. Please keep your child at home if they have a temperature of 38 or above. For sickness and diarrhoea, children must remain absent from school or nursery for 48 hours after the last episode.

**Punctuality** The school gates open at **8:45am** & close at **8:55am** please arrive on time. First thing in the morning is the most crucial time of the day when children settle in and find out what they will be doing that day. All children in all year groups are learning to support their reading first thing every morning, whether that be phonics or practising spellings. Arriving late for school can have a massive impact on your child's education, particularly their literacy skills, and their wellbeing.

- **172 minutes of learning time was lost last week. This is half a school day!**

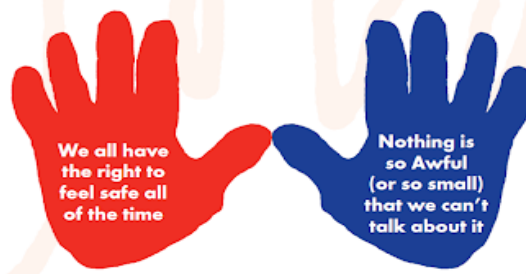
