#### Attendance and Punctuality for week beginning 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2023

**Punctuality** The school gates open at **8:45am** & close at **8:55am** please arrive on time. If the gate is locked and your child arrives through the main office doors, they are arriving late, and will receive a late mark, please avoid this and take a moment to explain to the office staff the reason.

- **7.5 hours** of learning time was lost due to children arriving late for school this week. This is more than one full school day. Well done to Year 6 who lost 5 minutes across the whole week.
- 23 children have been late this week, from 15 families, 2 families have had their 2 children late to school every day, totalling 180 minutes (3 hours)

It really is important for children to arrive to school on time. It can be very unsettling for them to walk into class a few minutes late, often missing out on the instructions for the morning. Please try to get up a little earlier so that you can leave the house a little bit earlier and your child can arrive in school on time.

### Before & After School Care

If your child is in Reception through to Year 6 and you would like to use our before or after school club please contact the school office.

Breakfast Club is open for drop offs between 7.30am and 8.30am for £3.00 per session, payable in cash on the day or in advance.

After school sessions are from 3.15pm until 5.30pm Monday to Thursday, at a cost of £10 per session. \* until 5.15pm on a Friday for £9.
