Attendance and Punctuality for week beginning 2nd March 2026

If your child is unwell and not able to attend school, you must inform us, either by calling the office and leaving a message via the absence line or sending a message via MyEd app, before 9am. Please keep your child at home if they have a temperature of 38 or above. For sickness and diarrhoea, children must remain absent from school or nursery for 48 hours after the last episode.

Punctuality *The school gates open at 8:45am & close at 8:55am please arrive on time.* First thing in the morning is the most crucial time of the day when children settle in and find out what they will be doing that day. All children in all year groups are learning to support their reading first thing every morning, whether that be phonics or practising spellings. Arriving late for school can have a massive impact on your child's education, particularly their literacy skills, and their wellbeing.

Nursery Places

We accept children the term after their 3rd birthday. Admissions are September, January and April. It is never too early to put your child's name down on our waiting list. We offer 15 hours of free funding to all families, this could be 5 mornings, 5 afternoons or 2 full days plus a half session each week. We also accept families who are in receipt of a 30 hours funding code, these children can attend all day. School Dinner Fees

From 1st April 2026 the new prices for school dinners will be **£3.25** for the Summer Term, the weekly fee will be £16.25. When we return to school in September school meals will be charged at £3.50 per day.


Communications

All Saints' Vision




