Lesson	Learning Goal (L.G.)	Brief outline of lesson content (Understanding Christianity: Gospel Lower Key Stage 2 Unit 2A.4) <u>What kind of world did Jesus want?</u>	Key Vocabulary covered
1	LG: engage with the idea of Gospel through parables	What is a parable? Recall examples: Boy who cried Wolf, The Thankful Leper (Luke 17: 11-19) The Thankful Leper (Luke 17: 11-19), The Good Samaritan. Recap that Christians believe Jesus' incarnation is 'good news' for all people. ('Gospel' means 'good news'.)	Gospel/good news Christians Jesus neighbour love and forgiveness
2	LG: enquire into the idea of Gospel	What does it mean to be a 'Good Samaritan'? Write a diary entry recounting events as the receiver of the kind act.	church worship social justice
3	LG: explore ways in which Christians practice Gospel	How can we live how Jesus wanted us to?	Leper Samaritan
4	LG: how does our local church practise Gospel?	Invite local vicar in (All Saints Church) to discuss regular day in their diary and compare to a Sunday. Why become a minister. What is the role of one in the community	Minster/ministry Charity/charitable
5	LG: how Christians can share God's message?	Children reflect on how they can spread the gospel, in particular, how to be kind.	

6	LG: research a Christian charity	Using Chrome Books to research a Christian Charity. What is the charity's message? Who, how and why does it help people?	
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
