1	<p>LG-To understand what the 'good news' is that Jesus brings.</p> <p>SEN- use of images e.g. prayer hands, dove, heart to reflect symbolism of the three offers of good news.</p>	<p>See attached planning. Begin with the role play scenario-page 2. Teach chn about the Gospel- New Testament, parables about Jesus and the good news. Explain how Jesus offered friendship, forgiveness and peace and how these three offers are the 'good news'. (Record on worksheet) Chn to think of 12 people that they would choose to change the world or the qualities that they would need e.g. strong, clever, kind, helpful, sharing etc. Explain how Jesus had 12 disciples that he chose to share the good news. Record chns responses on a flip chart with the Gospel symbol.</p>	<p>Gospel Bible Good news Parables New testament Jesus God</p>
2	<p>LG-To listen to a Bible story.</p> <p>SEN- role play story- Matthew the tax collector supported chn</p>	<p>See planning page 2. Read the story to the chn. Chn to recall the story on a story board.</p>	<p>Parable New testament</p>
3	<p>LG- To recognise that 'forgiveness' is good news to Christians.</p> <p>Respect</p>	<p>Ask pupils to work together to draw cartoons of people who need forgiving. Then ask them to draw a speech bubble from each person, with the word 'Sorry' in it. From above, draw speech bubbles saying 'You are forgiven'. Look at each other's work and discuss the idea that God forgives people who say sorry.</p>	<p>Forgiveness Lord's prayer Good news</p>
4	<p>LG- To recognise that 'peace' is good news to Christians.</p>	<p>Give pupils four heart outlines each. Get them to draw an image that shows a heart that is afraid, ill or worried, using three of the hearts. Talk about what they have expressed. Teach them Jesus' promise to his disciples from John 14:27: 'My peace I leave with you, my peace I give to you. Do not let</p>	<p>Peace Good news</p>

		<p>your heart be troubled and do not be afraid.' Jesus' first followers went through many troubles, but they had peace in their hearts. Christians today find peace in their faith too. Jesus is good news, say the Christians, because he gives his followers peace.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ask the pupils to think about four kinds of peace: peace in my own life (in my heart?), peace with other people (no fights?), peace in the world (no wars?), peace with God for Christians (being forgiven). <p>Ask chn to draw one or two of these ideas on the fourth heart shape: it could be their own idea, or they could think about what a Christian would draw to show peace, and why.</p>	
5	<p>LG-To explore peace in our lives.</p> <p>SEN- most chn drew images of what they find peaceful peace garden/rainbow room/assembly/home etc</p> <p>Liberty/respect/tolerance</p>	<p>Explain how Christians go to Church to find peace, ask for forgiveness, and have peace with themselves and God.</p> <p>Explore places around school that make the chn feel peaceful- peace garden, prayer/reflection area, prayer garden etc.</p> <p>Take photos of the areas that chn find peaceful.</p>	<p>As above Christians Prayer Reflection</p>
6	<p>LG To give examples of how Christians follow Jesus' teachings.</p> <p>SEN- images and charity website supported learning as well as first-hand experience of raising money for Aid to Africa</p> <p>Respect/Rule of law</p>	<p>Ask chn 'How do Christians show love to their neighbour? Explore the idea of how Christians may choose to help others e.g. charities to help the poor, homeless etc. Talk about how our school helps to raise money for 'Aid to Africa' to help children in Africa to have better experiences at school. Go through a power point on how this charity provides help to others, something that Jesus teaches his followers to do.</p>	<p>Charities Love Neighbour</p>
7	<p>LG- To understand the different types of peace that Christians believe in.</p>	<p>See planning page 3</p> <p>Teach chn the 3 types of peace- peace inside, peace between people and peace with God.</p> <p>Chn to TPS their ideas- record responses on a flip chart.</p> <p>Used a set of scenarios to support chn reflected their experiences e.g. forgiving friends/ saying sorry/praying to God/ writing prayers/reading prayers linked to resources.</p>	<p>As above Peace</p>
