## Online Safety Update

This week's newsletter will focus on the online, streaming service: **Netflix**. Netflix is a gaming-focussed live-streaming service where you can watch others play games live and listen to commentary as they play.

**SOME NETFLIX CONTENT HAS A PEGI RATING OF 18 YEARS.** It is therefore imperative that Parental Controls are activated to prevent your child accessing inappropriate content.

When the children were surveyed 60% of Key Stage 1, with 84% of the whole school, declare they regularly use the app.
