Community Christmas Lunch

This year we are re-opening our doors for our Community Christmas Lunch. There will be some changes to previous years.

Look out for the letter, it's going home this week.

Christmas lunch will be across two days, **Thursday 16th December and Friday 17th December**. Families will be allocated one of these days. Due

to reduced capacity, we will be inviting **one adult for each family**, please think about which adult will be coming in to enjoy a Christmas Lunch with your child/children. The cost of lunch will be free to those children in receipt of Free School Meals and all children in Reception, Year 1 & Year 2.

For all other children, the cost will be £2.25. The cost for the adult attending will be £3.25. Children's meals can be paid for in advance on the APP as normal, adult meals can also be paid for on the APP - the item is called Community Christmas Lunch. ALL orders must be placed by returning the slip on or before Wednesday 17th November 2021.



Aid2Africa



As part of our link to All Saints Church and their charity Aid2Africa which supports a school in Kenya, ALL children are being asked to donate 'coppers' 1 pence and 2 pence pieces. Each class has their own jar to fill with 1&2p's. We are asking for donations of copper coins to help equipment for the school in Kenya. The class with the most coins will receive an award at the end of term when all the coins are counted.

Non Uniform Day

Friday 26th November we will be having a non uniform day. All children are invited to wear their casual clothes to school in exchange for £1 - donations are to be paid in class on the day please.

Please ensure children wear suitable clothing for school, no bare shoulders, cropped tops, or shoes with heels or wheels.

Online Safety

Snapchat is a popular photo- and video- sharing app which also allows users to chat with friends via text or audio. Users can share their images and videos with specific friends, or through a 'story' (documenting the last 24 hours) visible to their entire friends list. Even if your child only connects with friends they know, they may still receive friend request from strangers. Alongside the 'disappearing messages' feature, Snapchat can be a harmful and is given the pegi rating of 13+ for those and many other reasons.

Some of the videos and posts are also not suitable for younger audiences and can be inappropriate and upsetting.
