



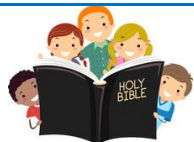

## School Uniform - PLEASE NAME ALL CLOTHING!

All children attending All Saints School are expected to wear school uniform. This is:

- A royal blue sweatshirt, cardigan or fleece, which can all be purchased from the school office.
- Grey trousers, skirt/pinafore. (no joggers or leggings)
- Grey shorts/blue and white checked or striped dresses in the summer.
- White polo shirt, white long sleeved shirt or white blouse.
- **BLACK SHOES** - flat and sensible. **NO TRAINERS**
- PE kit - white t-shirt, black shorts, trainers or black pumps to keep in school. PE kits are to remain in school for each half term, to go home and be washed in the holidays and returned. PE bags are available to purchase at school for £6.50
- Book bags are available to purchase for £5.50 for a small bag or £7.50 for the larger messenger style bag.

## Jewellery



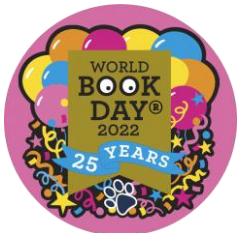
Children are **NOT** allowed to wear jewellery to school. No rings, necklaces or bracelets. If your child has his/her ears pierced the only style of earrings acceptable to be worn in school are studs.

Children **MUST NOT** wear hoop or dangly earrings. No more than one stud in each earlobe may be worn. We ask that earrings are removed for PE and swimming lessons, if they cannot be removed, they will be covered with Micropore tape.
