


SUPPORTING THE PREVENT DUTY IN WARWICKSHIRE SCHOOLS.

This school is committed to preventing the radicalisation of children and young people.

All staff, parents/carers and visitors are expected to notice, challenge and report acts of grooming, terrorism or radicalisation involving pupils/students, staff, parents or carers.

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- P** **Promoting** equality, diversity and positive relationships between children and young people.
- R** **Referring** following the Notice, Record, Report process. Respond in the same way you would to any other safeguarding concern.
- E** **Educate** students by providing opportunities for them to develop their critical thinking skills in relation to issues of radicalisation, extremism, grooming and terrorism.
- V** **Vigilant** – maintain constant vigilance about radicalisation, extremism and any other risk to the safety and wellbeing of children and young people, staff, visitors and the community that we serve.
- E** **Ensure** a safe and secure environment in which children and young people can learn, grow and flourish.
- N** **Never** dismiss your concerns, however small. Each piece of information may contribute to a wider picture of concerns that may need to be shared with partner agencies.
- T** **Training**, regular updates and a safeguarding induction will be provided by the local authority which will include the importance of safeguarding children and young people from extremism and radicalisation.
