Please remember – if your child is unwell and unable to attend school, you must inform us at the very earliest opportunity, either by calling the office or sending a text message via our MyEd app, ideally before 9am. Please keep your child at home if they have a temperature of 38 or above. For sickness and diarrhoea, children must remain absent from school or nursery for 48 hours after the last episode.

Punctuality The school gates open at **8:45am** & close at **8:55am** please arrive on time. First thing in the morning is the most crucial time of the day when children settle in and find out what they will be doing that day. Arriving late for school can have a massive impact on your child's education and wellbeing.

<u>School Dinners – September 2025</u>

Attention all families whose children will be moving from year 2 to year 3. Children in year 2 are currently eligible to Universal Free School meals. This will change from September once they are in year 3. It is really important that you contact Warwickshire Free School meals team online at https://www.warwickshire.gov.uk/education-learning/apply-free-school-meals or by calling 01926 359189.

The cost of school meals will be increasing by 10 pence to £2.85 per day, £14.25 per week. All school meals must be paid for in advance, termly, weekly or daily via the app: IRIS Parentmail available from Google Play and the Apple Store.

Our current menus will continue in Septmber as they run until October half term.

Guitar Lessons

From September, our guitar fees will be increasing 50 pence to £4 per week, payable either termly, in advance or on the day, all via the app.

As the year 6 children who currently have guitar lessons on a Monday morning will be leaving us. It opens up space for children who will be in year 4 in September, to take up guitar lessons. We hope to have 3 spaces available.
