Online Safety Update

This week's newsletter will focus on the game: **Call of Duty (COD)**.

We are focusing on a game from the gaming category this week. Call of Duty is undeniably one of the most recognisable video games on the planet. The first Call of Duty game was released for the PC way back in 2003, and the franchise has spawned a whopping 16 titles to date, and featured on almost 20 gaming consoles and devices. Despite being one of the most popular games on the market, Call of Duty has never been a stranger to controversy; themes of war, terrorism and other adult subjects' parents and guardians might feel uncomfortable exposing their children to, have always been a part of the series. The latest iteration, Call of Duty: Modern Warfare, is no different, however with more emphasis on mature themes.

In the guide, you'll find tips on a number of potential risks of Call of Duty such as violent content, talking with strangers and addictive behaviour. Please take time to read the guide to help you as parents and carers understand exactly what the game is about.
