A very warm welcome to our Nursery. We pride ourselves on offering a welcoming, safe and stimulating environment, with high quality teaching and learning experiences for children from 3 years old. We recognise that children's foundations for learning are embedded in their early years experiences and we work in close partnership with home to support learning and development together.

You are very welcome to come and look round our Nursery School - please telephone or come to Reception to make an appointment. We look forward to meeting you!

We offer both 15 hour and 30 hour spaces. Please contact the school office for more information.

Children come for half a day for five sessions a week - either 8.45 am until 11.45 am or 12:30 pm until 3:30 pm. We will do all that we can to meet your preference although this cannot be guaranteed.

It is also now possible to get a funded childcare place for up to 30 hours per week for your child which is 8.45 am until 3.30 pm if certain criteria are met. For more information please look at this attachment.

Before your child starts in nursery, you will be invited into our setting so you can get to know the adults and other parents/carers and children that will be joining too. You will also receive an induction pack with lots of useful information and have the opportunity to talk to all the staff and ask any question's you may have.

The Early Years Foundation Stage Framework outlines the expectations as being the minimum requirements your child must meet in order to ensure continued progress.

All the objectives will be worked on throughout the year and will be the focus of direct teaching as well as play based continuous provision.

Any extra support you can provide in helping your children by talking with them, reading to them and ensuring they attend Nursery every day would be most welcomed.
