**Persistent lateness can result in a penalty notice being issued, which carries a fine.**

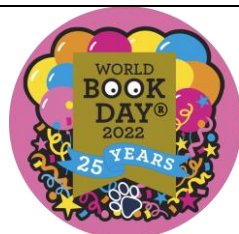


### Film Night for Aid2Africa
