Online Safety Update

This week's newsletter will give focus to the online, streaming service: Twitch. Twitch is a gaming-focussed live-streaming service where you can watch others play games live and listen to commentary as they play.

TWITCH HAS A PEGI RATING OF 13 YEARS AND OVER. IT IS NOT RECOMMENDED FOR PRIMARY SCHOOL AGED CHILDREN AND IS THEREFORE INAPPROPRIATE FOR ANY CHILD AT OUR SCHOOL TO USE.

When the children were surveyed 20% of Year 5 and 6, that's 9% of the school, declare they regularly use the app.

In the 'Twitch' **National Online Safety guide**, which is available on the school website, you will find information on a number of potential and concerning risks. There are many.
