Online Safety Update

This week's newsletter will focus on the social media platform: **Facebook Messenger**. Facebook Messenger is a communication and chat application which is part of the wider Facebook platform and has been a standalone app on mobile devices since 2011. Through Messenger, users can exchange messages and send photos, videos, stickers, gifs, audio files and play games. It allows both one-to-one conversations and group chats, has a 'stories' feature and provides the ability to set up a video call session with up to 50 people at a time through its latest update, Messenger Rooms.

In the guide you will find tips on a number of potential risks such as cyberbullying, screen addiction and secret conversations. Please take time to read the guide to help you as parents and carers understand exactly what Facebook Messenger is about.

Facebook Messenger HAS A PEGI RATING OF 13 YEARS AND OVER. IT IS NOT RECOMMENDED FOR PRIMARY SCHOOL AGED CHILDREN AND IS THEREFORE INAPPROPRIATE FOR ANY CHILD AT OUR SCHOOL TO USE.

When the children were surveyed, 79% of them across the school admit to regularly using the app.
