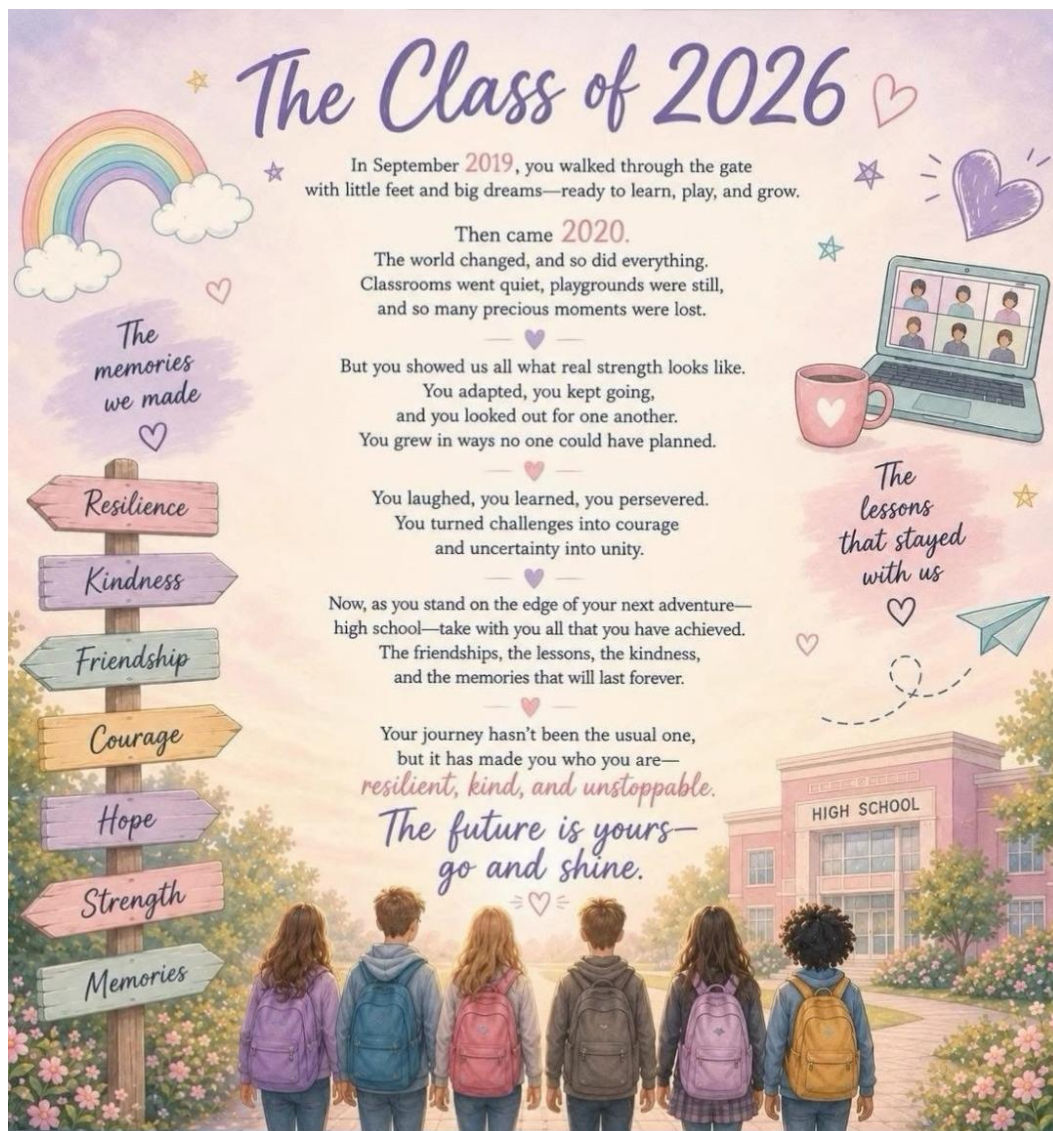

All parents and carers of children in Year 6 are invited to join us for their 'Leavers Assembly' this Wednesday, 15th July at 2pm.



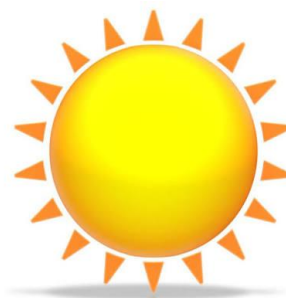
Reminder - Warm Weather Update

The weather forecast is a little cooler this week than last week. Hopefully much more pleasant. Pupils can continue to wear their PE kits this week.

Either:

A plain white t-shirt with black shorts, with pumps or trainers.

Or, pupils are welcome to continue wearing their usual school uniform if they prefer. With their school shoes, pumps or trainers.



Please note that no other clothing is permitted. Clothing in non-school colours should not be worn. Footwear that is not school shoes, trainers or pumps, should not be worn. Pupils should not wear crocs, open toe sandals or any footwear that is similar.

Attendance and Punctuality for week beginning 6th July 2026

If your child is unwell and not able to attend school, you must inform us, either by calling the office and leaving a message via the absence line or sending a message via MyEd app, before 9am. Please keep your child at home if they have a temperature of 38 or above. For sickness and diarrhoea, children must remain absent from school or nursery for 48 hours after the last episode.

Punctuality *The school gates open at 8:45am & close at 8:55am please arrive on time.* First thing in the morning is the most crucial time of the day when children settle in and find out what they will be doing that day. All children in all year groups are learning to support their reading first thing every morning, whether that be phonics or practising spellings. Arriving late for school can have a massive impact on your child's education, particularly their literacy skills, and their wellbeing.
