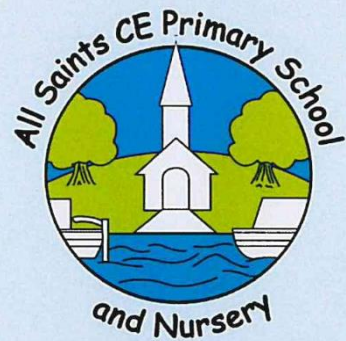
At the end of the year, I will leave with the very best of memories and I am confident that the school will continue to go from strength to strength.
