2	Open and respond to an email and use an address book	Purple Mash - Email Unit - Lesson 2 Children can open an email and respond to it. Children have sent emails to other children in the class. 3	Learn how to use email safely -( part 1)	Purple Mash - Email Unit - Lesson 3 Children have written rules about how to stay safe using email. Children have contributed to classmates' rules. Extension: Children understand the importance of draft.	Safe, rules, importance
4	Learn how to use email safely - (part 2)	Purple Mash - Email Unit - Lesson 4 Children have created a quiz about email safety which explores scenarios that they could come across in the future. Extension: Children create title screens for their quizzes explaining what the quiz is about, and how to play it.	
5	Add an attachment to an email	Purple Mash - Email Unit - Lesson 5 Children can attach work to an email. Children know what CC means and how to use it.	Attach, attachment, CC - Carbon Copy,

6	Explore a simulated email scenario	Purple Mash - Email Unit - Lesson 6 Children can read and respond to a series of email communications. Children can attach files appropriately and use email communication to explore ideas.
