School Closures

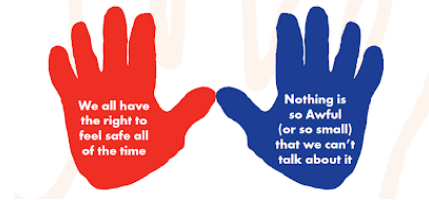
In the event of school being closed due to adverse weather conditions, we will always try to contact all parents and carers directly via our school text messaging service and our website

Spring Term Film Night

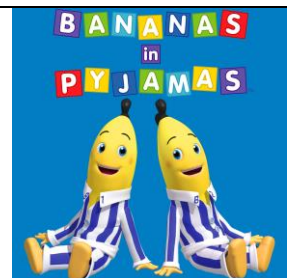

Measles cases in West Midlands

If your child has not had their MMR Vaccination and you would now like them to, or you are unsure if they should, please contact your GP to get this booked in or to discuss the vaccination with a medical professional.
