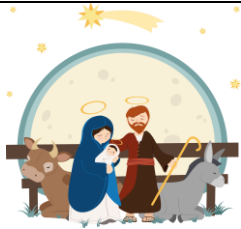


Sponsored Times Tables

Peer Mediators

'Conflict resolution for young people by young people'

Year 5 recently completed their Peer Mediation training- a programme of conflict resolution skills training, led by the Young Peacemakers Project. This follows on from the Peacemakers Project in Year 4.

During the training, Year 5 practised the skills to help younger children resolve their own disagreements - this is done through a 5-step mediation process. This equips our children with the awareness and skills to manage conflicts with others. The skills learned not only help the children who are chosen to be Peer Mediators but all Year 5 and the All Saints community.

Some of the qualities we have been looking for from our potential mediators are good listening, someone who is calm and respectful, a great team worker, someone who doesn't take sides or gossip and someone who can solve problems.

Keep your eyes peeled as we will soon be announcing who has been successfully chosen as Year 5 Peer Mediators for 2021/22.
