### MyEd App and +Pay

Many of our parents and carers have been using the MyEd App and +Pay to pay for school dinners, school uniform trips and events on line., as we move away from accepting cash payments at the school office. If you do not already have the app, please go to your App store to download the MyEd app. It will take 24 hours to link you to your child. Once it has recognised your child you can then click on the MyStudents section. This will take you to a new page with a +P button. Click on the button to be redirected to the Parentmail payment section. Initially it will take a few minutes to set up, but once it's done it will be very quick to make a payment.

Please, where possible pay on the app, or by phone with your debit card, rather than paying cash at the office.

## Online Safety Update

Following on from the theme of 'Growing Together' from Children's Mental Health week.

This week's newsletter will focus on the social media platform: **Instagram**.

Instagram is a hugely popular social networking app with over 1 billion users worldwide. The app, which is accessible on iOS and Android devices, allows users to upload images and videos to their feed, create interactive 'stories', exchange private messages or search, explore and follow other accounts they like.

Images and videos can be transformed with an array of filters to edit the shot before sharing and anyone with an account can see others' online 'galleries' if their account is not private. To make posts easier to find, users can include searchable hashtags and captions to their uploads.

In the guide, you'll find tips on a number of potential risks such as exposing your child's location, in-app purchases and poor mental wellbeing. Please take time to read the guide to help you understand exactly what Instagram is about.
