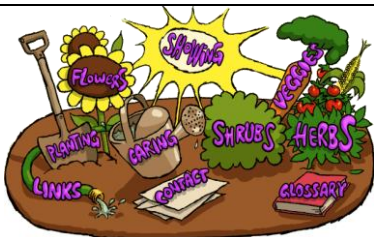
It's Good to Grow from Morrisons
