The Expected Behaviour of Parents and Visitors

Dear families,

Unfortunately, there have been recent incidents involving parents on, or very close to, the school site when you and young children who are with you may have witnessed unacceptable behaviour by other parents. It is very disturbing that you and your family members may have witnessed the use of obscene language by a very small number of parents. Furthermore, school staff should not have to be concerned that children taking part in outdoor activities on the school grounds might hear highly inappropriate discussions and foul language. The school does not condone this behaviour and will inform the relevant authorities (including our legal advisors) if any further incidents occur. You will see from the school's policy on parental behaviour that breaches of this policy may result in parents being banned from the school site. This would include our driveway.
