Nursery children Reception Place School Applications

Children who have their 4th birthday on or before 31st August 2022 (born between 01/09/2017 & 31/08/2018) are due to start Reception class in September 2022. The application process is now open, please apply at www.warwickshire.gov.uk/applyforschool or [phone 01926 414143](tel:01926414143). The deadline for applications is 5pm on Saturday 15th January 2022. Applications made after this date will not receive their offer on National Offer Day. The National Offer Day is Tuesday 19th April 2022, all places must be accepted by 3rd May 2022.

Please note children attending our Nursery are not guaranteed a place in Reception, please ensure you complete the application as soon as possible.

Year 6 children Secondary School Applications

Children in Year 6, who have their 11th birthday on or before 31st August 2022 need to apply for their Year 7 place at Secondary school. The application process is now open, please apply at www.warwickshire.gov.uk/applyforschool or [phone 01926 414143](tel:01926414143). The deadline for applications is 5pm on Sunday 31st October 2021. Any applications made after this date will not be processed until after the National Offer Day, by which time your preferred choice of secondary school may be full. The National Offer Day is Tuesday 1st March 2022

Swimming Lessons - Year 4 children

Year 4 had their first swimming lesson at The Pingles Leisure Centre began last Friday morning. They were all very well behaved, both walking to and from the Pingles and whilst in the pool.

Lessons are every Friday morning, children can come to school wearing their swimwear, swimsuit or trunks (no bikinis) under their uniform. Please ensure they bring: a towel, underwear and goggles if they wear them. Please ensure earrings have been removed. Please encourage your child to practice getting dry and dressed by him/herself quickly. Staff do not do this for children.

Online Safety

During the summer holiday, the National Online Safety website emailed out some PDF's of some online content that parents/carers need to be aware of. The first one is called Deep Fakes. Deep Fakes are when videos, static images and audios are created falsely to spread fake news. However, they can appear very real. There is also one called Echo Chambers which is used to share and direct viewpoints and influence ways of thinking and persuading users to view more content promoting similar views. This is very common on social media platforms. For more information on both of these please see the guides on the Online Safety Page of the website.

In addition, there is a new APP that has launched over the summer holiday called 'Hoop'. Hoop is used to synchronise with Snapchat and allows users to build their community of friends. It works in a similar way to Tinder where users can swipe left and right when choosing to accept or reject who to connect with. This therefore, shares their personal information with this APP and allows communication to then take place through Snapchat, whether this is video/audio calling, messaging or image sharing. This can create all sorts of risks due to being able to connect with strangers. For more information on the risks this APP poses please see the guide on the Online Safety Page of the website.
