Online Safety

Unwrap new experiences, entertainment and fun while also protecting your children online. 'Tis the season... to go shopping... and whether it's phones, tablets, consoles, or wearables, technology gifts continue to top the Christmas wish-lists of many children and young people. UK Safer Internet Centre has created four top tips for parents and carers to consider before those devices, whether new or 'new to you', are unwrapped on December 25th so that you can have peace of mind knowing your child will be unwrapping a gift of future fun and entertainment while avoiding any risks.

- 1. Set up and play with the device before wrapping** - explore the safety settings, reporting tools, and other features on the device you've just bought is by testing it yourself. Make sure your internet filter is also on for protection for the whole family when online.
- 2. Discuss your expectations** - such as daily screen time allowances, where the device is kept at night, approving friend requests, and permission to download or purchase apps. It's worth thinking whether you want devices in their bedroom or only in family rooms where you can keep an eye on what they are accessing.
- 3. Give practical safety tips** - simply talking to your children about their interest online and asking if they know what to do if someone is unkind online or if someone they don't know tries to befriend them.
- 4. Keep the conversations** going and keep the door open for them to speak to you if they are worried about something online.
