This week's newsletter will focus on the Grand Theft Auto- better known as GTA. **Grand Theft Auto** is an adult action-adventure video game.

GRAND THEFT AUTO COMES WITH A CONTENT WARNING AND HAS A PEGI RATING OF 18 YEARS AND OVER. IT IS NOT RECOMMENDED FOR PRIMARY SCHOOL AGED CHILDREN AND IS THEREFORE INAPPROPRIATE FOR ANY CHILD AT OUR SCHOOL TO USE.

When the children were surveyed 12% of Year 5 & 6 declare they regularly play this game. In the 'GTA' National Online Safety guide, which is available on the school website, you will find information on a number of potential and concerning risks. There are many.
