Dear families,

From 25<sup>th</sup> September we are starting our 'Reading for Pleasure' campaign.

You are invited to come into school to choose a 'reading for pleasure' book with your child from their key stage class library.

This will take place on one allocated morning per week for each year group from 9:00am until 9:15am.
