### Years 5 & 6 visit to Black Country Living Museum

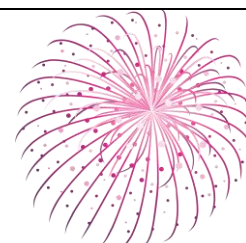

In Year 6 we have Mya Lumsden, Luke Ison and Sarina Miah.

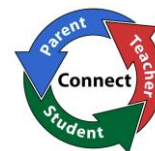
We want to congratulate those who were successful and say thank you to all those who applied. It was a very tough decision for both Miss Lomas and Miss Rouse as we had so many good applications.
