**Punctuality** The school gates open at **8:45am** & close at **8:55am** please arrive on time. If the gate is locked and your child arrives through the main office doors, they are arriving late, and will receive a late mark, please avoid this and take a moment to explain to the office staff the reason.

## **Reading for Pleasure**

Our 'reading for pleasure' campaign begins 26<sup>th</sup> September. Families are invited to come into school to choose a 'reading for pleasure' book with their child from their key stage class library. This will take place on one allocated morning per week for each year group from 9:00am until 9:15am.

**Tuesday** Reception and Year 3, **Wednesday** Year 1 and Year 5, **Thursday** Year 2 and Year 4, **Friday** Nursery and Year 6.

For adults, we have a 'Book Swap' tent under the canopy at the front of school, families are welcome to take a book, read it and bring it back. If you would like to donate books for adults to read, we would be happy to accept them, but please be careful of the content, children may very well pick up these books. We DO NOT want anything along the lines of '50 shades'!



#### **Before & After School Care**

If your child is in Reception through to Year 6 and you would like to use our before or after school club please contact the school office.

Breakfast Club is open for drop offs between 7.30am and 8.30am for £3.00 per session, payable in cash on the day or in advance.

After school sessions are from 3.15pm until 5.30pm Monday to Thursday, at a cost of £10 per session. \* until 5.15pm on a Friday for £9. Half sessions are currently available, these are from 3.15pm until 4.30pm or from after school sports club until 5.30pm at a cost of £6 per session. Late collections will be charged at £5 per 15 minutes.

After school club must be booked and paid for in advance, via the app or in the office. # **Online Safety**

#### PEGi and BBFC ratings.

If you have children, it is understandable to have concerns about the films and TV shows they watch, as well as the games they play. In this guide, we take a look at the two official ways you can assess if a particular title is suitable for your child. Both the BBFC and PEGI have search facilities on their websites that can be used to look up individual titles so you can check their ratings.

All classification decisions are a lengthy process and take into consideration the content and the impact of the viewer's feelings and their view of the world. Their aim is to help families choose what's right for them and avoid what's not. The PEGI rating considers the age suitability of a game, not the level of difficulty. Some PEGI 18 games are very easy to play, yet they contain elements that make them inappropriate for a younger audience. Follow the link below to download the guide for yourselves.




# **Special Lunch**
