### Harvest Food Bank Collection

From today Monday, 27<sup>th</sup> September we will begin collecting contributions of food for the Nuneaton Food Bank. Please DO NOT send baked beans, soup or dry pasta as they have plenty of those. You may wish to send toothpaste, deodorant, shampoo, conditioner and shower gel. Children will be able to make their donations in class. Thank you for your support.

### Non Uniform Days

On Friday 15<sup>th</sup> October and Friday 26<sup>th</sup> November, we will be holding Non Uniform days. Children are invited to wear their casual, sensible clothes in exchange for paying £1 towards school fundraising. Please ensure children do not wear 'crop tops' heeled shoes or shoes with wheels. Please pay in class.

### Children feeling unwell during Covid pandemic

If your child has a high temperature, a new continuous cough and loss or change to their sense of taste or smell, they **MUST** remain at home. **DO NOT** send them to school. Arrange for a full Covid PCR test - not a lateral flow. A sore throat is a potential symptom but is less common. If your child does have a sore throat or other symptoms and you think they may have COVID-19, they must stay at home and you need to call your doctor or NHS direct to discuss symptoms.

If someone in your household tests positive for COVID, children living in that household **MUST** have a PCR test, they can continue attending school unless the PCR test is positive. Adults who have had both vaccinations and children under the age of 18 years and 6 months **DO NOT** have to isolate if they come into contact with anyone with COVID, they need to take a PCR test but do not need to isolate whilst they await the results.
