

WHAT IS GEOGRAPHY?



Geography is the study of places and the relationships between people and their environments.

A geographer is a physical scientist, social scientist or humanist whose area of study is geography. They explore the physical properties of Earth and the human behaviour across it.

There are three types of geography: physical geography (the effects it has on people and the environment), human geography (concerned with people) and environmental geography (how people behaviour can affect the environment).




What have you been learning about in Geography?




- Making maps drawing the park, flowers and trees.



Why is it important to learn Geography?




- So we know what is happening in places around the world.
