## Online Safety Update

Last week in school we celebrated **Children's Mental Health Week** with the theme of **Growing Together**. We were able to make links between this and our **Safer Internet Day** by giving our children opportunities to discuss and reflect on how we can interact positively with others online.

In the spirit of **Mental Health** we have also included the how to '**Be Kind**' online guide which suggests tips such as thinking twice before posting a comment that might use unkind words.

This week's newsletter will focus on the online, streaming and social media platform: **TikTok**. TikTok is a video-sharing social media app which lets people create, view and download looping 15 second clips.

When the children were surveyed 64% of Year 5 and 6 and 40% of KS1 children admit to regularly using the app.

In the TikTok guide, you will find information on a number of potential and concerning risks. There are many.
